

King's Schools: 2016-17 Tuition & Fee Schedules

Christian education is a priceless gift for your children that will last them a lifetime. We understand and appreciate the financial commitment families make when deciding to send their children to King's. In turn, we strive to keep King's accessible with a mindful pricing schedule and an impactful financial aid program.

Application Fee: Testing Fee:	\$50 per student, payable with new student application, and is <u>non-refundable</u> . For students who may need further assessment to determine eligibility for matriculation, a testing fee of \$100 per student is required.
Enrollment Fee:	\$225 per family each year, payable at registration, and is <u>non-refundable</u> . This fee reserves your student's placement. A discounted fee is available for returning families that register their student(s) during the Early Re-enrollment Period.
K-12 Building Fee:	\$385 per K-12 student, up to a maximum of \$1,155 per family, for maintenance and improvements on our campus. This annual fee is not pro-rated for early withdrawal/dismissal or late enrollment.
Senior Fee:	Non-refundable fee of \$300 charged at the beginning of the Senior Year for senior class activities.

Tuition

King's tuition is an annual rate covering the entire school year.

* The multiple student discounts are determined from highest grade level to lowest grade level for families with more than one student enrolled. All students are charged at the annual tuition rate then receive a 2nd, 3rd, or additional students discount for the amount indicated above.

Early Withdrawals/Late Enrollments: Preschool tuition is pro-rated by month for early withdrawal or late enrollment (30 day minimum notice required). Tuition is due for any month in which the student is enrolled. Elementary & Secondary tuition is pro-rated by 9-week academic term (quarter) for early withdrawal or late enrollment. Tuition is charged in full for any term in which the student is enrolled.

Payment Options

King's provides three payment plans to accommodate families' varying budget needs.

- Annual Plan 1 payment of annual tuition and building fee, paid in full by August 1st (September 1st for Preschool tuition). King's offers a 3% tuition discount with the annual plan.
- Semi-Annual Plan 2 equal payments due on August 15th and January 15th for annual tuition and building fee
- Monthly Plan 10 equal payments due on the 15th of each month, August through May (September through June for Preschool tuition). In cases of late enrollment, payments are allocated over the remaining months of the monthly plan schedule.

Extended care fees, course fees, optional activity fees, and other charges are billed and due as incurred throughout the school year, unless otherwise noted on the fee schedule. Notification is sent to families at the time when the charges are applied to the family account.

Financial aid is available for full-time students in Kindergarten through 12th grade. Financial aid is awarded on the basis of family financial need. For more information, contact the Business Office at (206) 546-7381 or go to <u>www.kingsschools.org</u>.

Extended Care

King's Preschool offers packages for extended care to its students. Preschool students must be registered in an extended care program to attend extended care (30 day minimum notice is required for add-ons or withdrawals). No drop-in attendance is allowed.

King's Elementary offers extended care through King's Kids Club (KKC). K-6 students are automatically registered in KKC for before/after-school care. Student care is billed at an hourly rate of \$9.00, based on actual usage, unless a package option has been selected. Please contact KKC for information on monthly packages.

Additional Optional Fees

King's strives to make our tuition inclusive and does not charge additional fees for textbooks, supplies, field trips, and many of the special programs and activities that enrich our students' learning experience. However, additional fees are assessed for some of King's elective courses, interscholastic athletics, and competitive activities (i.e. Mock Trial, DECA, and Robotics). The course fees help to cover expenses in excess of normal and customary costs for specialized course supplies, books, or travel required for the elective course. Athletic and competitive fees help offset the extra costs for equipment, officials, and travel for athletic teams and competitions at the local and state level.
