**TRANSCRIPT EXPLANATION** | King's High School follows a two-term block schedule. Each term includes 4 full blocks plus a shortened "flex" block that falls at the beginning of the day. Students attend one set of classes from September to January and another set of classes from February to June. Each full block class is awarded two credits and assigned grades twice (the equivalent of one year's worth of work). Each "flex" block class is assigned one credit (the equivalent of one semester's worth of work). Sixty-four credits are required for graduation; classes are not weighted.
