



King's Schools: 2021-22 Tuition & Fee Schedules

Christian education is a priceless gift for your children that will last them a lifetime. We understand and appreciate the financial commitment families make when deciding to send their children to King's. In turn, we strive to keep King's accessible with a mindful pricing schedule and an impactful financial aid program.

- Application Fee:** \$50 per student (\$100 for Preschool), payable with new student application, and is non-refundable.
- Testing Fee:** For students who may need further assessment to determine eligibility for matriculation, a testing fee of \$100 per student is required.
- Enrollment Fee:** \$225 per family each year, payable at registration, and is non-refundable. This fee reserves your student's placement. A discounted fee is available for returning families that register their student(s) during the Early Re-enrollment Period.
- K-12 Building Fee:** \$475 per K-12 student, up to a maximum of \$1,425 per family, for maintenance and improvements on our campus. This annual fee is not pro-rated for withdrawal/dismissal or late enrollment.
- Senior Fee:** Non-refundable fee of \$325 charged at the beginning of the Senior Year for senior class activities.

Tuition

King's tuition is an annual rate covering the entire school year.

* The multiple student discounts are determined beginning with the child in the highest grade level at the full tuition rate then moving down in grade level order for the 2nd, 3rd, or additional student discounts when a family has more than one child enrolled.

Cancellation, Withdrawal, and Late Enrollment: Written notice of enrollment cancellation must be received and confirmed by the School on or before July 1st. A minimum charge equal to 10% of the annual tuition will be due for enrollment cancellations received thereafter until the first day of the school year. Once the school year has begun, Preschool tuition is pro-rated by month for withdrawals or late enrollment with a 30-day written notice required. Elementary & Secondary (Grades K-12) tuition is pro-rated by 9-week academic terms (quarter) for withdrawals or late enrollments. Enrollment during any part of a quarter requires payment of tuition for the **entire** quarter; this includes circumstances such as withdrawal by parents and dismissal from the school. Building and senior fees are annual fees that are not pro-rated regardless of early withdrawal or late enrollment during the school year. The balance of tuition & other fees is due in full at the time of withdrawal. Prepaid tuition will be refunded for wholly unused periods after all other outstanding fees are paid in full at the time of withdrawal.

Payment Options

King's provides three payment plans to accommodate families' varying budget needs.

- **Annual Plan** – 1 payment of annual tuition and building fee, paid in full by August 15th. King's offers a **3% tuition discount with the annual plan**.
- **Semi-Annual Plan** – 2 equal payments due on August 15th and January 15th for annual tuition and building fee
- **Monthly Plan** – 10 equal payments due on the 15th of each month, August through May. In cases of late enrollment, payments are allocated over the remaining months of the monthly plan schedule.

Extended care fees, course fees, optional activity fees, and other charges are **billed monthly on the 15th** and due as incurred throughout the school year, unless otherwise noted on the fee schedule. Notification is sent to families at the time when the charges are applied to the family account.

Financial aid is available for full-time students in Kindergarten through 12th grade. Financial aid is awarded on the basis of family financial need. For more information, contact the Business Office at (206) 546-7392 or go to www.kingsschools.org.

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Extended Care

King's Preschool offers morning extended care for its students. Preschool students must be pre-registered for the extended care in order to attend; no drop-in attendance is allowed. Morning care is available from 7:00am-8:30am at a monthly rate of \$225. 30-day minimum notice is required for add-ons or drops. Please contact the Preschool office for more information and available spots with our morning extended care program.

King's Elementary offers extended care through King's Kids Club (KKC). K-6 students are automatically registered in KKC for before/after-school care. Student care is billed at an hourly rate of \$12.00, based on actual usage, unless a package option has been selected. Please contact KKC for information on monthly packages.

Additional Optional Fees

King's strives to make our tuition inclusive and does not have extra charges for textbooks, supplies, field trips, and many of the special programs and activities that enrich our students' learning experience. However, additional fees are assessed for some of King's elective courses, interscholastic athletics, and competitive activities (i.e. Mock Trial, DECA, and Robotics). The course fees help to cover expenses in excess of normal and customary costs for specialized course materials or travel required for the elective course. Athletic and activity fees help offset the extra costs for equipment, officials, and travel for competitions at the local and state level.

¹ Additional fees may be incurred for students choosing to participate in solo and ensemble competitions or auditioning for All-Northwest (High School students). Please consult the course instructor for more details.

NOTE for Living Faith and KHS Live

Participation in a group mission trip may be required. Costs of the mission trip will be determined in the fall and payment due dates will be scheduled between January and March. Living Faith and KHS Live mission trips generally cost between \$1,200 and \$2,500 per participant. A non-refundable \$250 deposit for this trip is collected in the fall by the school.

² Participants may incur additional athletic expenses for items such as personal equipment, shoes, pictures, clothing, off-season camps, physicals, and extended team travel. Coaches will communicate these costs in advance to families as they arise.

Other optional activities may be offered throughout the year for a fee. Fees for these activities will be communicated in advance. Examples of past activities are: ASB/Leadership retreats, Ashland Shakespeare Festival Trip, Spring Break Mission Trips, DECA Conferences, Robotics National Championship, and other student club activities.

Transportation Fee - King's bus service is available in many areas for an additional fee. Daily round-trip service is \$1,560 (billed monthly at \$156 for 10 months). Daily one-way service is \$1,200 (billed at \$120 for 10 months). Rates are per individual rider with discounted rate offered for multiple riders in a household.
