JUNIOR HIGH ELECTIVES

ART

ART FUNDAMENTALS | Students explore drawing, painting, clay, and sculpture.

EXPLORATIONS IN ART | Explorations in Art is a class for beginning and developing artists. Students build the skills to become a stronger artist!

ATHLETICS

INTRAMURALS | Intramurals focuses on positive competition in a variety of sports and activities. Students will develop, maintain, and improve skills that will extend beyond the scope of the general PE class.

DRAMA

DRAMA INTRODUCTION 7th grade only. Pre-requisite for Advanced Drama/Musical. This class is designed to introduce students to the many aspects of drama: auditioning, acting, singing, and dancing.

ADVANCED DRAMA/MUSICAL | 8th grade only. Must have taken Drama Introduction. Act, sing, and dance on the big stage! Students learn all the performance skills necessary to perform in the 8th grade musical.

MUSIC

GUITAR | Introduction & Advanced. Students learn chords and strumming on acoustic guitars as well as master basic songs.

BAND 7th grade only. No experience required! Students choose their own instrument and learn to assemble, maintain and play it.

TECHNOLOGY

VIDEO PRODUCTION | Lights, camera, action! Students learn how to use video cameras and video editing software.

LANGUAGE & LIFE

SPANISH 1 8th grade only. This course has high expectations both for attendance and academic performance.

CONSUMER SCIENCES | In this hands-on course, students learn how to read a recipe and prepare items in the kitchen in a small team setting, grow herbs and veggies to cook with, learn beginning sewing methods, and more!

GAMES OF LIFE | Students learn strategy and servanthood through board games and reflect on the games of life.

LEADERSHIP

DISCOVERING In this project-based learning class, students learn more about their personal backgrounds, skills, aptitudes, interests, spiritual gifts, and future goals.

LIVE TO LEAD | 8th grade only. Students can be part of the 8th grade student council and discover their leadership potential, developing communication, and teamwork skills.

KNIGHTS ON PURPOSE | Required for all 7th grade students. Students learn what it means to transition to KJH, and to join and shape our school culture.

INTRODUCTION TO MOCK TRIAL Introduction 7th grade only. Pre-requisite for Advanced Mock Trial. Students learn how to study a case, find important themes and details, and role play various roles in a case (lawyer, witness).

ADVANCED MOCK TRIAL | Adanced 8th grade only. Must have taken Introduction Mock Trial and been officially invited by teacher. Students will learn the official rules of mock trial competition, and their team will compete against the high school mock trial team, in front of a judge.
