COLLARED SHIRTS

COLOR: black or white

STYLE: collared cotton or dry-fit polo

LENGTH: short or long sleave

LOGO: plain or King's logo only. Logo optional.

SWEATSHIRT & SWEATERS

COLOR: black or red (girls only)

STYLE: vest and cardigan sweaters, crewneck and quarter

zip sweatshirts

LOGO: King's logo required. Embroidered on sweaters, printed on sweatshirts. *Note: collared shirt must be worn*













PANTS & SHORTS

COLOR: khaki

STYLE: pants, bermuda shorts, jeggings (with back pockets)

LENGTH: shorts must be no more than 2" above knee

SKIRTS

COLOR: khaki or plaid

STYLE: skirt or skort (black or white tights or

leggings can be worn under skirts)

LENGTH: must be no more than 2" above knee







COLLARED SHIRTS

COLOR: black or white

STYLE: collared polo or dry-fit LENGTH: short or long sleave

LOGO: plain or King's logo only. Logo not required.

SWEATSHIRT & SWEATERS

COLOR: black

STYLE: sweater vest, crewneck and quarter zip sweatshirts LOGO: King's logo required. Embroidered on sweater, printed on sweatshirts. *Note: collared shirt must be worn*







PANTS & SHORTS

COLOR: khaki

STYLE: slacks, joggers (no sweats), or shorts

LENGTH: short or long

WHERE CAN I PURCHASE MY CHILD'S UNIFORM PIECES?

On the King's website or stores that carry uniform pieces like Target, Costco, Children's Place, Nordstrom, Old Navy, and Amazon.

DOES MY CHILD HAVE TO WEAR THE KING'S BRANDED UNIFORM PIECES?

Logos are optional on collared shirts. However, the only sweatshirts and sweaters allowed in the classroom will be the King's branded logo apparel, found on the King's website.

DO STUDENTS ALWAYS HAVE TO WEAR A COLLARED SHIRT?

Students must always wear a shirt with a collar. Collared shirts can be black or white, as well as short sleeve or long sleeve. You have the flexibility to purchase the King's branded collared shirts or purchase your own. When layering with approved King's uniform outwear, a collared shirt must still be worn underneath.

WHERE CAN I PURCHASE COLLARED SHIRTS THAT DO NOT HAVE TAGS?

We have a dry-fit, tagless collared shirt available on the King's website.

WHAT FABRIC DO THE COLLARED SHIRTS HAVE TO BE?

Parents can choose whatever fabric their child likes best for collared shirts. The King's site offers several fabric choices.

CAN RAIN JACKETS AND OTHER OUTERWEAR BE WORN INSIDE?

Rain jackets, coats and non-uniform jackets may only be worn outside the classroom.

WHAT KIND OF SHOES AND SOCKS CAN STUDENTS WEAR?

Socks should be solid, black or white. Students can wear their shoes of choice. When choosing shoes, please ensure they are appropriate for school and meet all dress code standards. (No wheelies, open-toe, etc)

CAN MY CHILD WEAR A HAT TO CLASS?

Hats are not allowed inside classrooms or school buildings.

CAN STUDENTS WEAR JEGGINGS?

Girls can only wear tan jeggings with pockets from The Childrens Place.

CAN GIRLS WEAR TIGHTS OR LEGGINGS?

Black or white tights or leggings may be worn under skirts only.

CAN MY CHILD PICK OUT THEIR OWN ACCESSORIES?

Students can wear accessories that are not distracting.

FRIDAYS WILL BE A KING'S SPIRIT DAY!

On Fridays, students can wear any King's branded tops with uniform bottoms. This is the only time students are allowed to not wear a collared shirt.

WILL THERE STILL BE DRESS UP DAYS DURING SPIRIT WEEK?

Free dress up days will be approved by Campus Principals.

HOW WILL DRESS CODE VIOLATIONS BE HANDLED?
