
KING'S CAMPUS

INTERNATIONAL ON-CAMPUS BOARDING FACILITY

On-campus boarding for international students provides an opportunity to live on a beautiful 55-acre campus and be fully immersed in our vibrant King's community. There are 22 rooms available to students with double and triple occupancy options, private security access, residential advisors, and transportation for activities.

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
SPIRITUAL LIFE AT KING'S SCHOOLS
